

Submission Guidelines



 Authors are requested to submit the abstract/Full paper in MS-word format at the below mentioned Email ID:

- The manuscript should be in MS-word format. Manuscript must be double spaced, with 1-inch margins with "Times New Roman, font size 12, black"
- In the first page of the paper (Cover page), please provide full names and full addresses (Institute's address along with designation and correspondence address) along with email address of the author(s). The author's name or affiliations should not appear anywhere else in the body of the manuscript to facilitate in blind peer review process.
- The actual paper should commence from the second page containing the title followed by the abstract, keywords and the main paper. The paper should have an Introduction, literature review, objectives, research gaps, methodology, limitations / scope for future work and conclusion.

- Full papers are limited to 4000-5000 words, including figures, tables and appendix given at the end. Headings and subheadings must be short and not numbered. The primary heading should be in capitalized form (upper case), and bold face. The sub-headings should be in title-case capitalization (first letter of each word in capital) and in bold. Table should be numbered consecutively. The title of the table should be placed above the table. The source should be indicated at the bottom.
- References should be included at the end of the paper and arranged in alphabetical order. The references must follow the style guide of the American Psychological Association (APA) 6th edition.

Publication Opportunity

Selected papers presented at the conference will have publication opportunities in reputed and indexed International and National Journals strictly subject to positive peer review by the journal editorial board. Only full papers will be considered for publication opportunities.

Remaining papers presented in the conference will be published in an edited book with an ISBN Number on a later date post-conference.

Note: The participants need to acknowledge the presentation of their paper in the conference, and are required to meet with the aim and scope of the Journal. Also, papers considered for publication do not mean the guarantee of publication.





All papers will be evaluated through the double-blind review process by experts from Institutions/ Universities/ Organizations of repute in and outside India. Only the original and unpublished work will be considered for presentation as well as publication. Any paper found identical or substantially similar to already published, presented or under review work will not be considered for the conference. All submissions would go through a Turnitin plagrism check and shared with the review panel along with the full paper/ extended abstract. The best paper based on the evaluation recommendation of the panel of judges in the session will be awarded.



The award selection committee will select the best paper from each track and the selected papers will be awarded a cash prize of up to Rs. 5,000/-



GUIDELINES FOR ABSTRACT

The electronic version of the paper must include a clear indication of the purpose of research, objectives, research methodology major results, implications, and key references. They should adhere to the following :

- 1. All text should be in 1.5 space with 1-inch margins on all the sides on A4 size paper using the Font Times New Roman of size 12
- 2. First page of the paper should include title of paper, name of the author with contact details and name of the organisation
- 3. Second page of manuscript should have the abstract of 200 words
- 4. References should be arranged in alphabetical order and as per the APA (American Psychological Association) Guidelines.



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
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
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
