He talked about ----- "Yuva kya hota hai, the spirit to stand up alone, to take personal initiative(s), being the core spirit and essence of Gandhiji's principles.

Dr Vishas also deliberated upon "Strength of Gandhiji's peaceful campaign" and Mahatma's firm belief in "Women empowerment and emphasized upon "Nari Shakti/Stree Shakti being the strength of Gandhiji's peaceful protest."
