
Guidelines for First Internal Examination (Moodle Quiz)

1. Check your schedule of Moodle Quiz properly and get ready on time. Students should join 5 minutes prior to the scheduled time of the exam. In case you have any problem related to login ID and Password then contact Mr. Pawan Rohilla at 9718070729.
2. Students shall their MST Id's and login through laptop only. Use of mobile phone is strictly prohibited during the exam. Camera should be kept open for the entire duration of the exam. If any student does not join MS teams or keep their cameras off during the exam, then exam of the student may be canceled.
3. Detailed schedule (Date Sheet) of the Moodle quiz is being shared with you on your ERP and website both. Read it carefully.
4. Don't skip any questions as you will not be able to go back and attempt that question again.
5. Moodle Quiz will be of 40 questions. Each question will appear on a different page. Attempt the question and move to the next page.

6. After attempting last question, you need to submit quiz.
7. After submitting the quiz your grades will be displayed on the screen. Make sure to log out after seeing your grades.
8. Duration of quiz will be of 30 minutes (thirty minutes) for theory papers and 45 (forty five) minutes for Practical papers.
9. Quiz window will be closed after 30 minutes.
