
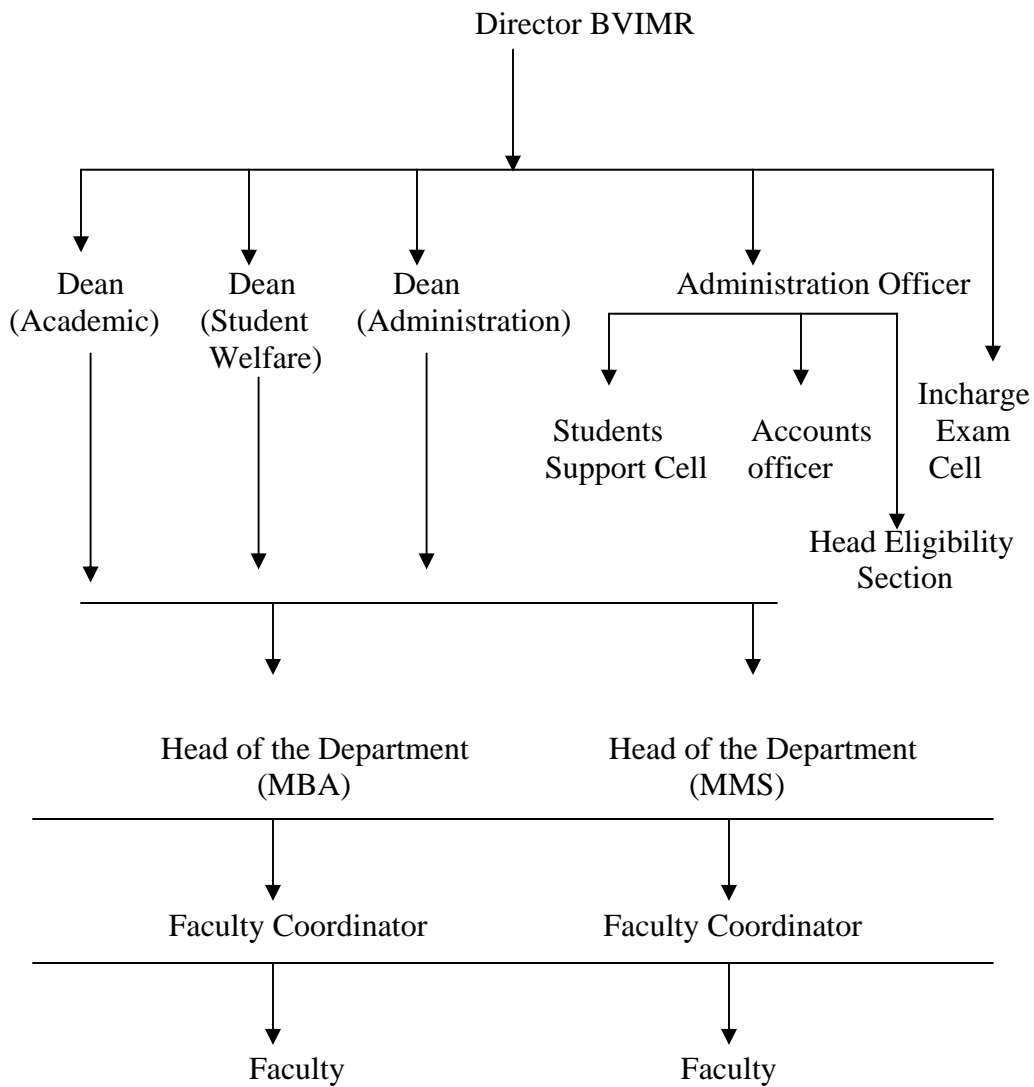

Management Development Programmes

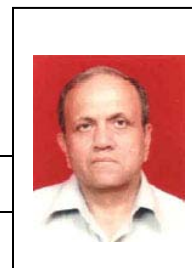
