LANGUAGE QUIZ

The language quiz is a multi-stage session of questioning, to brush up their basic concepts and learning. Starting with the basics that were learned in the class the quiz will move towards a more intense round of questioning.

Event rules:

- Each team should have only 2 members (1 German and 1 French).
- Stationary would be provided by the College.
- Selection on first come first basis.
- The specific rules regarding evaluation procedure, time to reply and the type of round will be given before the actual start of the competition.
- Judgment by the judges will be final & binding to all parties.
- **Students from college having one of the above mentioned language will be provided with a partner by our Institute.**

RANGOLI MAKING

“Art is unquestionably one of the purest and highest elements in human happiness. It trains the mind through the eye, and the eye through the mind. As the sun colors flowers, so does art colors life.”

Rangoli making: the creativity in each of the participant is at the helm here. The pure magic of colors and human imagination combine together with a connection to either or both the languages.

Event rules:

- A team of Max. 2-3 participants from each institute/college.
- Necessary materials to be brought by the teams only.
- Topic and place for making rangoli will be allotted on the spot and at the end participants have to relate their Rangoli to the given theme.
- Time duration for preparation: 60 minutes.
- Use of natural material (like Flowers, Sand, Pulses, etc.) is permitted and no chemicals at all.
- Judgment by the judges will be final & binding to all parties.

ONE ON ONE CONVERSATION

Be yourself. Above all, let who you are, what you are, what you believe, shine through every sentence you write, every piece you finish.” This event holds the most basic application and also the necessary step of studying any language is being able to use it to create conversations. Hence by providing interesting situations and with a dictionary in hand, participants will be required to add words their thoughts.

Event rules:

- Members in each team- 2 (both of same language).
- Time for conversation is 8-10 minutes.
- Topic will be given in the morning at the time of registration.
- Use of dictionary is permissible.
- Selection on first come first serve basis.
- Judgment of the judges will be final and binding to all parties.

TREASURE HUNT

“That’s elementary Doctor Watson!!!”

Treasure Hunt, involves an intriguing web of clues which lead to others clues and along the voyage the team must collect the clue items.

Event Format

- Each team should have only 2 members (1 German and 1 French)
- Clues placed on selected locations within the college
- Clues in both German and French.
- One clue leads to the other clues and teams have to go through all make to the finish.
- Along the way teams need to collect clue items to prove that all clues were solved.
- **Students from college having one of the above mentioned language will be provided with a partner by our Institute.**

Event rules:

- Teams must consist of 2 members only (1 German & 1 French)
- Only helping item allowed along is a Dictionary.
- Selection on first come first serve basis.
- Team must collect all items within 60minutes or the team with maximum items will be the winner.
- Judgment of the judges will be final & binding to all parties.

COLLAGE MAKING

“A dream collage id pictures of your goals. It is like your future photo album”.

Collage making would comprise of the student’s creativity in portraying his/her thoughts about the theme by using bits and pieces in whatever way one wants to.

Event rules:

- 2-3 members in the group.
- Total time to prepare collage: 60 minutes.
- Topic and place will be informed beforehand.
- No use of scissors and cutters will be allowed.
- Selection on first come first serve basis.
- Judgment of the judges will be final & binding to all parties.

TATTOO MAKING

There is no argument that the most unique, jaw-dropping tattoos are the ones that people design by themselves. Drawing a tattoo can be a great challenge, whether the tattoo is for you or for someone else. So come and be a part of it.

Event rules:

- 2 participants per team (1 making a tattoo and 1 getting a tattoo made).
- Total time to prepare tattoo: 30 minutes.
- Necessary materials to be brought by the teams only.
- To make something related to French/ German.
- Judgment of the judges will be final & binding to all parties.
